Communication on latest amendments to the Regulation (EU) 10/2011

Regulation (EU) 2025/351

Regulation (EU) 2025/351 from 21.2.2025 or so called “Quality amendment” has introduced several amendments to the Regulation (EU) 10/2011. Most predominant changes applicable to plastic intermediate materials are the re-emphasis on high degree of purity (*Article 3a*) for the substances used in the manufacture of plastic materials and adequate information on the presence of non-intentionally added substances (NIAS) (*point 6 of Annex IV*).

Before confirming this Regulation in our DoC’s we will need support and input from our raw materials suppliers in order to provide as accurate information as possible, and *this will take time*. We are actively working with our supply chain to have all necessary information and confirmations in place. DoC’s will be updated as soon as possible – latest within the timeframe specified in the Regulation. The Regulation requires intermediate material producers to report on any non-compliance by 16 December 2025.
