Colour Tone confirms that there are no raw materials restricted from use in electrical and electronic equipment as stated in EU Directive 2011/65/EC (as amended) present in the formulation of the masterbatch described in para.2.

5. Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (as amended).

Colour Tone confirms that, based on information provided by our raw material suppliers, it is our understanding that all substances used by Colour Tone Masterbatch in the manufacture of the masterbatch described above have been registered or are in the process of being registered under the REACH Regulation.

The products manufactured by Colour Tone are classified in REACH as mixtures and are not, therefore, required to themselves be registered under the REACH legislation.

The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) periodically introduces amendments to the candidate list of substances of very high concern (SVHC) for potential inclusion in Annex XIV (substances requiring Authorisation for continued use). There are no SVHC present in the masterbatch described in para.2.
