Re: Recent update to The Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) and Impact on Lubrizol Products:

Dear valued customer,

Thank you for your continued interest in Lubrizol products.

The recent update (June 14, 2023) to the Candidate List saw the list of substances increase to 235. The following substances are the most recent additions to the list:

- Diphenyl(2,4,6- trimethylbenzoyl)phosphine oxide (EC 278-355-8)
- Bis(4-chlorophenyl) sulphone (EC 201-247-9)

Lubrizol does not routinely perform analytical tests on products, however based on the most up to date recipe, raw material information and our own manufacturing and handling practices, we do not expect the aforementioned substances to be present in Lubrizol products from the Engineered Materials product portfolio and Life Science Health- medical business product portfolio at $\geq 0.1\%$ or above any other regulatory disclosure threshold.

Lubrizol routinely communicates the known presence of SVHCs at $\geq 0.1\%$ in Sections 3 and/or 15 of the EU safety data sheet and therefore any new and subsequent additions to the Candidate List will be reflected in the EU SDS provided with the product. In case a SDS update is needed, we will communicate this upfront to accommodate for the transition time needed to get the documents adjusted.
