

Declaration According to European Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning Substances of Very High Concern (REACH-247 SVHC)

MBA Polymers UK Ltd. is principally a manufacturer of preparations made from recycled material. The company therefore applies an exemption from registration according to Article 2, (7) (d). Safety Datasheets are available. MBA Polymers uses a 3rd party, certified test laboratory to analyse each of its' material types for Substances of Concern (SoC) compliance every 6 months. Also, our additive suppliers are committed to comply in every respect to the requirement of REACH and relevant amendments (we have been assured that they have registered their products).

We have determined that our products are manufactured without the use of Substances of Concern covered in the following Regulations:
