Subject: REACH EU Regulation No 1907/2006¹ - Substances identified as SVHC:
 Updating of the “Candidate List” according to ECHA/NR/24/29² of 25 June 2025

Dear Customer,

On 25 June 2025, ECHA added two substances to the Candidate List. They are very persistent and very bioaccumulative. They are used, for example, in cosmetics, personal care products and in automotive care products. One substance is toxic for reproduction and is used in textile treatment products and dyes.

The Candidate List of substances of very high concern now contains 250 entries for chemicals that can harm people or the environment.

We are therefore glad to inform you that all the grades supplied by RadiciGroup High PerformancePolymers, with the trademarks:

do not contain, neither as raw material nor as intentionally added additives, substances identified as SUBSTANCES OF VERY HIGH CONCERN (SVHC)

Substances of Very High Concern are defined in Article 57 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and includes substances that are:

- Carcinogenic, Mutagenic or toxic for Reproduction (CMR), meeting the criteria for classification in category 1 or 2 in accordance with Directive 67/548/EEC³;
- Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) or very Persistent, very Bioaccumulative (vPvB) in accordance with the criteria set out in Annex XIII of the REACH Regulation; and,
- Substances for which there is scientific evidence, evaluated on a case-by-case basis, of probable serious effects to human health or the environment which give rise to an equivalent level of concern to those of the above mentioned substances (e.g. endocrine disrupters).

According to our best state of knowledge, they are not present apart from traces below the declaration threshold limit of 0.1% (weight by weight).

Please note that the inclusion of a substance on the candidate list does not automatically lead to a substitution and subsequently to a ban. Listing only indicates that these substances might become subject to authorization.

As only candidate substances may become subject to authorization this SVHC statement implicates substances listed in **Annex XIV of the REACH regulation**.

Since the presence of the chemicals referred to above is not reasonably foreseeable, no specific analysis is performed regularly on our standard products in order to verify the presence and content of the same substances.

SCIP is the database for information on **Substances of Concern** in articles as such or in complex objects (Products) established under the Waste Framework Directive (WFD).

Companies supplying **articles** containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) on the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) on the EU market have to submit information on these articles to ECHA, as from 5 January 2021.

Due to the fact SVHC are not present in our products, apart from traces below the limit of 0.1% (weight by weight), and we do not produce articles, we are not obliged to notify to SCIP.

Companies supplying **materials** containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) on the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) are obliged to indicate it in the section 3 of the SDS.
