- raw material and additives are typical of the Product according to its physical content (NO mass-balance approach)
- energy consumption, emissions*, water use and waste production are Site Specific
- transportation of raw materials is accounted as Site Supply Average.

No allocation is applied. Cut-off rule for the inventory is set below 1 % of the total material inputs.
